Description:

- Information gathering (including, but not limited to, literature surveys, inventories, audits), data analysis (including computer modeling), document preparation (such as conceptual design or feasibility studies, analytical energy supply and demand studies), and dissemination (including, but not limited to, document mailings, publication, and distribution; and classroom training and informational programs), but not including site characterization or environmental monitoring.

Rational for determination:

The State of Hawaii will use \$5,270,158 in Recovery Act funds to accelerate electric vehicles adoption and charging infrastructure in Hawaii. Funding will be applied to:

1) assist Hawaii State and County government fleets with the deployment of electric, advanced technology, and alternative fuel vehicles and charging infrastructure;

2) the Hawaii Transportation Energy Diversification Program, a rebate and grant program to accelerate the adoption of electric drive vehicles and stimulate market demand for the availability of alternative fueled and advanced technology vehicles, including alternative re-fueling stations and networks or electric vehicle charging infrastructure;

3) the "Transportation Energy Transformation" for staffing needs and related support;

4) studies and economic models to address specific concerns and evaluate complex food, fuel, land, water, transportation, and energy scenarios;

5) community events including the Kohala Energy Conference; Bio Conference; Kauai Energy Conference; and other Transportation Conferences, Workshops, and Seminars.

The work identified involves energy efficiency and conservation measures combined with information gathering and outreach. The nature and scope of the work is addressed in the SEP Template. Based on the information provided, I have determined that the work identified can be classified as A9, A11, and B5.1.
