Description:

B5.1 Actions to conserve energy, demonstrate potential energy conservation, and promote energy-efficiency that do not increase the indoor concentrations of potentially harmful substances. These actions may involve financial and technical assistance to individuals (such as builders, owners, consultants, designers), organizations (such as utilities), and state and local governments. Covered actions include, but are not limited to: programmed lowering of thermostat settings. placement of timers on hot water heaters, installation of solar hot water systems, installation of efficient lighting, improvements in generator efficiency and appliance efficiency ratings, development of energy-efficient manufacturing or industrial practices, and small-scale conservation and renewable energy research and development and pilot projects. The actions could involve building renovations or new structures in commercial, residential, agricultural, or industrial sectors. These actions do not include rulemakings, standard-settings, or proposed DOE legislation.

Rational for determination:

The State of Illinois will provide \$100,000 in Recovery Act funds to the Hiawatha Community Unit School District #426 to install a ground source heat pump system at the high school. The system will replace the existing HVAC components at the school and permit individual classroom control of temperature, heating, and cooling. Existing unit ventilators and perimeter heating elements, including controls, will be replaced by the new equipment.

The proposed ground source heat pump system will be a 100-ton closed loop, vertical system. The well field will have approximately 70 boreholes drilled to a depth of 450ft. The boreholes are not expected to come in contact with groundwater. The drilling will be performed by a state licensed and/or certified driller who will be required to follow IGSHPA and NWGA guidelines and design standards for geothermal installations. The boreholes will be grouted with a thermally enhanced bentonite grout designed to withstand cracking from temperature changes, use high density polyethylene pipe that is heat fused at the joints to minimize the risk of leaks, and use a non-toxic mixture of propylene glycol and potable water as refrigerant. Installation of the system will require excavation. Upon completion of the installation, the area will be returned to original conditions via soil compaction, seeding, and other general restoration measures. There are no floodplains or coastal zones in proximity to the proposed site. The nearest wetland is 0.25 miles from the site.

In view of the information provided by the State and recipient, the work outlined is consistent with provisions identified in Categorical Exclusion B5.1 "actions to conserve energy."
