Description:

B3.6 Siting, construction (or modification), operation, and decommissioning of facilities for indoor bench-scale research projects and conventional laboratory operations (for example, preparation of chemical standards and sample analysis); small-scale research and development projects; and small-scale pilot projects (generally less than two years) conducted to verify a concept before demonstration actions. Construction (or modification) will be within or contiguous to an already developed area (where active utilities and currently used roads are readily accessible).

Rational for determination:

DOE is proposing to provide federal funding to the recipient to complete laboratory scale research and development activities related to sustainable energy production from biomass via anaerobic biotechnology.

All laboratory work will be done on the campus of Marquette University in the College of Engineering Water Quality Center, on a bench scale and will follow Marquette University standard operating procedures.

The College of Engineering has a Chemical Hygiene Manual along with lab-specific protocols on file which outline many of the safety protocols in place. Adherence to protocols are monitored by the lead PI and lab manager in each laboratory internally, and also by the Marquette University Environmental Health and Safety Department.

The Wisconsin Association of Independent Colleges and Universities conducts EPA –level environmental Inspections every 3 years to assure compliance with State of Wisconsin RCRA chemical handling and disposal Regulations.


