Description:

Rational for determination:

The Arizona Department of Commerce Energy Office will administer the EECBG Program for the state of Arizona. The State of Arizona would pass through 80% of DOE EECBG to the non-formula Arizona counties and cities via a program called the ABS (Arizona Balance- of- State) EECBG program. All projects under this program are bounded in compliance with the uploaded and signed EECBG Template for Expedited NEPA review.

The Arizona Balance -of-State EECBG program will provide a finical incentive program to the non formula communities in which a competitive sum of funding will be presented to the communities and in return the State will receive EECBG activities proposals from the non formula counties and cities based on the EECBG Bounded Categories activities.

Any projects that fall outside the scope of the template are conditioned pending further NEPA review.

These projects comprise education, technical advice, and actions to conserve energy; therefore they are categorized under CX A9, A11, and B5.1.
