Description:

B5.1 Actions to conserve energy, demonstrate potential energy conservation, and promote energy-efficiency that do not increase the indoor concentrations of potentially harmful substances. These actions may involve financial and technical assistance to individuals (such as builders, owners, consultants, designers), organizations (such as utilities), and state and local governments. Covered actions include, but are not limited to: programmed lowering of thermostat settings. placement of timers on hot water heaters, installation of solar hot water systems, installation of efficient lighting, improvements in generator efficiency and appliance efficiency ratings, development of energy-efficient manufacturing or industrial practices, and small-scale conservation and renewable energy research and development and pilot projects. The actions could involve building renovations or new structures in commercial, residential, agricultural, or industrial sectors. These actions do not include rulemakings, standard-settings, or proposed DOE legislation.

Rational for determination:

The State of Illinois will provide \$138,000 in Recovery Act funds to Champaign Unit 4 School District to install a ground source heat pump (GSHP) system in the Bottenfield Elementary School. The system is projected to have a capacity of 138 tons, sufficient to replace the current unit ventilator and boiler system.

The borefield will be on school grounds. The grounds consist of lawns in close proximity to schools in an urban environment. Work shall include, but is not limited to, backfilling, soil compaction, seeding, and general restorations to previous conditions.

At present, engineers estimate the need for 130 to 200 bore holes that will be drilled to a depth of 275 feet. The work is to be conducted by a state licensed and/or certified driller. The boreholes will be grouted in a thermally enhanced bentonite grout designed to withstand cracking from the changes in temperature, will employ high density polyethylene pipe that is heat fused at the joints to minimize the risk of leaks, and will use a refrigerant that is a non-toxic potable water/propylene glycol mixture.

Construction permits will be submitted with the Regional Office of Education (ROE) for Champaign County. Waste materials will be disposed in accordance with local regulations. An analysis of the affected area indicates an absence of surface and/or subsurface hydrology. The surrounding residential drinking water supply is municipally provided by Illinois American Water.

Based on information provided by the State and recipient, the work outlined in consistent with activities identified in Categorical Exclusion B5.1.
