Proposed Action or Project Description

American Recovery and Reinvestment Act:

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The Leisnoi Village-Woody Island Tribal Council proposes to 1) conduct energy efficiency audits and 2) conduct building retrofits/energy upgrades to the Tribal Council Building. The energy audits would be conducted on residential and commercial buildings. The building retrofits to the Tribal Council Building (constructed in 1979) would involve removing and replacing insulation and sealing all penetrations; installing insulation on the walls and plastic on the floor of the crawl space, as needed, and installing an additional door and vents in the crawl space; installing gable vents in the attic for proper ventilation; building code retrofits (e.g., installing attic access door and leveling and re-supporting the entrance of the building); replacing windows, doors, and storm doors; and replacing the existing boiler and associated fuel tank and lines with an energy-efficient system.

Conditions: None

Categorical Exclusion(s) Applied: A9, B2.5, B5.1

This action would not: threaten a violation of applicable statutory, regulatory, or permit requirements for environment, safety, and health, including DOE and/or Executive Orders; require siting, construction, or major expansion of waste storage, disposal, recovery, or treatment facilities, but may include such categorically excluded facilities; disturb hazardous substances, pollutants, contaminants, or CERCLA-excluded petroleum and natural gas products that pre-exist in the environment such that there would be uncontrolled or unpermitted releases; or adversely affect environmentally sensitive resources (including but not limited to those listed in paragraph B.(4)) of Appendix B to Subpart D of 10 CFR 1021). Furthermore, there are no extraordinary circumstances related to this action that may affect the significance of the environmental effects of the action; this action is not "connected" to other actions with potentially significant impacts, is not related to other proposed actions with cumulatively significant impacts, and is not precluded by 40 CFR 1506.1 or 10 CFR 1021.211.
