Rational for determination:

East Penn Manufacturing Company proposes to use federal funds to research and develop test materials for advanced battery anodes that allow for energy generation fluctuations to equal peak demand periods. Upon successful trials, batteries will be built and tested for their charge and discharge behavior.

This project will comprise of installation of necessary equipment, experimental trials to determine the expected mixing ratios with standard UB (UltraBattery) capacitor material, drying of the capacitive material in an oven, and testing of the finished product.

The applicant has submitted an R & D questionnaire which thoroughly addresses chemical and safety protocols.

This project comprises of conventional research and development of an UltraBattery; therefore a Catex B3.6 will apply.
