Description:

B5.1 Actions to conserve energy, demonstrate potential energy conservation, and promote energy-efficiency that do not increase the indoor concentrations of potentially harmful substances. These actions may involve financial and technical assistance to individuals (such as builders, owners, consultants, designers), organizations (such as utilities), and state and local governments. Covered actions include, but are not limited to: programmed lowering of thermostat settings, placement of timers on hot water heaters, installation of solar hot water systems, installation of efficient lighting, improvements in generator efficiency and appliance efficiency ratings, development of energy-efficient manufacturing or industrial practices, and small-scale conservation and renewable energy research and development and pilot projects. The actions could involve building renovations or new structures in commercial, residential, agricultural, or industrial sectors. These actions do not include rulemakings, standard-settings, or proposed DOE legislation.

Rational for determination:

The State of Louisiana will provide \$1,095,913 in Recovery Act funds to the City of Bossier City to install two compressed natural gas (CNG) and E85 facilities in the vacinity of the City. One station (CNG and E85) is to be located at 4520 Barksdale Blvd, Bossier City; the other (CNG and E85) will be located at 2580 E. Texas Avenue, Bossier City.

The Texas Avenue location is a vacant lot close to interstate 20 and state highways 79, 80, 71 and 3. The surrounding area is retail and commercial. The station is to be located approximately 250 feet from the nearest office building or home. The Barksdale location is a vacant lot close to interstate 20 and state highways 71 and 511 and Barksdale AFB. The surrounding area is retail and commercial. That station is also to be located approximately 250 feet from the nearest office building or home.

The objective of this project is to provide public access compressed natural gas refueling infrastructure. The project involves the installation of above-ground compression equipment, storage tanks and fast-fill dispensers. This will also involve installing card readers and station monitoring software. Recovery Act funds will be used for the engineering and design of the station; site preparation; purchase of CNG/E85 supplies, materials, and equipment; and installation of the stations. Site preparation work at the Texas Avenue location has already commenced.

In view of the information provided by the State and recipient, DOE has determined that the work outlined will not cause significant harm to human health, environment, or habitat. This determination has been made in consideration of the nature of the work to be performed and the sites where the work will be conducted. The work outlined is consistent with activities identified in Categorical Exclusion B5.1.
