Description:

B3.6 Siting, construction (or modification), operation, and decommissioning of facilities for indoor bench-scale research projects and conventional laboratory operations (for example, preparation of chemical standards and sample analysis); small-scale research and development projects; and small-scale pilot projects (generally less than two years) conducted to verify a concept before demonstration actions. Construction (or modification) will be within or contiguous to an already developed area (where active utilities and currently used roads are readily accessible).

## Rational for determination:

The proposed project intends to develop a process that will combine saccharification and fermentation processes in one stage for the purpose of turning biomass into biofuel. The research will be conducted at the wet chemistry and biological laboratory facilities located at 130 North Main St, Butte MT, 59701. The University uses various (OSHA, ANSI, and the US Centers for Disease Control and Prevention) safety protocols and incidence response guidance. In addition the University has a Director of Research and Development who monitors the labs and makes sure safety protocol is followed. This work will not require additional permitting, and no GMOs will be used.

There will be no new building construction (or expansion of an existing building) as a result of the proposed project.

The proposed project consists of research and development; therefore it is categorically excluded under B3.6 from further NEPA review.
