Description:

## Rational for determination:

Fayette County, PA will use DOE funding under the Competitive EECBG Grant Award for activities that are bounded in compliance with the uploaded and signed NEPA Statement of Work (SOW) template. Aspects of this project include financial incentives, marketing and outreach, training and educational opportunities.

The description of project activities is described below as submitted in the EF-1:

Funding for the project will support an energy efficiency and awareness outreach/marketing campaign, a series of residential and non-residential energy audits (which includes assistance in the identification and handoff to qualified implementation subcontractors) as well as project management, assessment and reporting efforts over the three year life of the project.

Awareness and marketing includes the development and distribution of print materials, a website (which will include energy efficiency related tools and videos), email communications, public workshops, social media, press releases and public service media campaigns.

The audits will be conducted by certified energy assessors and will include specialized pre-assessment forms to assist in tracking the impact of the project. Energy audits will include evaluation and recommendations related both to relevant energy systems, as well as behavioral modifications that may assist in energy efficiency and conservation efforts.

Project management, assessment and reporting efforts will be undertaken to ensure the satisfaction of project objectives and identify best practices. Reporting will be done in accordance with the Federal Reporting Assistance Checklist following the instructions provided therein.

These projects as described above comprise administrative, financial and personnel actions, education, technical advice, and actions to conserve energy; therefore they are categorized under CX A1, A9, A11, and B5.1.
