Description:

B5.1 Actions to conserve energy, demonstrate potential energy conservation, and promote energy-efficiency that do not increase the indoor concentrations of potentially harmful substances. These actions may involve financial and technical assistance to individuals (such as builders, owners, consultants, designers), organizations (such as utilities), and state and local governments. Covered actions include, but are not limited to: programmed lowering of thermostat settings, placement of timers on hot water heaters, installation of solar hot water systems, installation of efficient lighting, improvements in generator efficiency and appliance efficiency ratings, development of energy-efficient manufacturing or industrial practices, and small-scale conservation and renewable energy research and development and pilot projects. The actions could involve building renovations or new structures in commercial, residential, agricultural, or industrial sectors. Rational for determination:

MN SEO will give \$8,697.50 to David Walter to install a 6 ton ground source heat pump system with a horizontal loop field. The ground disturbance will be 4'W x 15'L x 8' D for the header pit excavation. There will be 4 directional bores at 205' length each. The system will be connected to the home by a directional bore of 100'. There will be no deforesting for this project.

No wetlands or flood plains or coastal zones will be affected. All maps are attached to the EF1 to view. The installer will check withthe MN Dept of Health, the County Well index for hydrology and geology conditions in the vicinity of the

This project was submitted to SHPO and the SHPO in MN concludes that no historic properties listed on or eligible for the National Register of Historic Places will be affected by the propsed project. The letter is attached to this EF1 as well.

The MN GSHP Rebate Program requires contractors to be licensed and/or bonded as applicable under state or local requirements.
