Description:

- B5.1** Actions to conserve energy, demonstrate potential energy conservation, and promote energy-efficiency that do not increase the indoor concentrations of potentially harmful substances. These actions may involve financial and technical assistance to individuals (such as builders, owners, consultants, designers), organizations (such as utilities), and state and local governments. Covered actions include, but are not limited to: programmed lowering of thermostat settings, placement of timers on hot water heaters, installation of solar hot water systems, installation of efficient lighting, improvements in generator efficiency and appliance efficiency ratings, development of energy-efficient manufacturing or industrial practices, and small-scale conservation and renewable energy research and development and pilot projects. The actions could involve building renovations or new structures in commercial, residential, agricultural, or industrial sectors. These actions do not include rulemakings, standard-settings, or proposed DOE legislation.
- A9** Information gathering (including, but not limited to, literature surveys, inventories, audits), data analysis (including computer modeling), document preparation (such as conceptual design or feasibility studies, analytical energy supply and demand studies), and dissemination (including, but not limited to, document mailings, publication, and distribution; and classroom training and informational programs), but not including site characterization or environmental monitoring.
- B3.6** Siting, construction (or modification), operation, and decommissioning of facilities for indoor bench-scale research projects and conventional laboratory operations (for example, preparation of chemical standards and sample analysis); small-scale research and development projects; and small-scale pilot projects (generally less than two years) conducted to verify a concept before demonstration actions. Construction (or modification) will be within or contiguous to an already developed area (where active utilities and currently used roads are readily accessible).

Rational for determination:

Saint Josephs University proposes to use federal funding to analyze the adaptability of switchgrass for climate change related to growth, physiological, and biochemical responses.

This project will include analyzing changes in the biomass, physiology, and tissue biochemistry of switchgrass in response to climate change. This project will also comprise of design, installation, and utilization of a mixed-plant type green roof system on the Science Center. Education and community outreach will be done to present the research to the public from this award.

Rights of entry have been obtained from Kansas State Univeristy and Emporia State University research area's at the Konza Prairie Long-Term Ecological Research (LTER). Sampling of switchgrass will take place here and laboratory work will take place in the Science Center at Saint Josephs University. An R & D Questionnaire has been submitted which thoroughly addresses chemical and safety handling protocols. No GMO's will be used in the implementation of this project.

This project comprises of information gathering, conventional research activities, actions to conserve energy through the use of a green-roof technology; therefore a CX A9, B5.1, & B3.6 will apply to this project.
