Description:

B5.1 Actions to conserve energy, demonstrate potential energy conservation, and promote energy-efficiency that do not increase the indoor concentrations of potentially harmful substances. These actions may involve financial and technical assistance to individuals (such as builders, owners, consultants, designers), organizations (such as utilities), and state and local governments. Covered actions include, but are not limited to: programmed lowering of thermostat settings, placement of timers on hot water heaters, installation of solar hot water systems, installation of efficient lighting, improvements in generator efficiency and appliance efficiency ratings, development of energy-efficient manufacturing or industrial practices, and small-scale conservation and renewable energy research and development and pilot projects. The actions could involve building renovations or new structures in commercial, residential, agricultural, or industrial sectors. These actions do not include rulemakings, standard-settings, or proposed DOE legislation.

Rational for determination:

Morgan Solar Inc proposes to use federal SEP funds to install equipment within there existing facility to expand its concentrated photovoltaic solar panel manufacturing capacity within their own building. They plan to install a lightguide mold, a tray mold, a deflecting layer mold, an injection molding machine, a custom assembly machine, and a custom package equipment machine.

The applicant does not plan to expand its current building footprint at the Nypro facility. All aspects of this project will take place within the existing infrastructure. The applicant has provided CEQA documentation that states the new equipment will not exceed the current manufacturing capacity as previously approved by the City of Chula Vista.

This project is comprised of installation of equipment to expand the manufacturing capacity of solar panels; therefore a CX B5.1 will apply.
