B5.1 Actions to conserve energy, demonstrate potential energy conservation, and promote energy-efficiency that do not increase the indoor concentrations of potentially harmful substances. These actions may involve financial and technical assistance to individuals (such as builders, owners, consultants, designers), organizations (such as utilities), and state and local governments. Covered actions include, but are not limited to: programmed lowering of thermostat settings, placement of timers on hot water heaters, installation of solar hot water systems, installation of efficient lighting, improvements in generator efficiency and appliance efficiency ratings, development of energy-efficient manufacturing or industrial practices, and small-scale conservation and renewable energy research and development and pilot projects. The actions could involve building renovations or new structures in commercial, residential, agricultural, or industrial sectors. These actions do not include rulemakings, standard-settings, or proposed DOE legislation.

Rational for determination:

Loudon County is proposing to use \$250,000 in EECBG funding to reduce the number of physical servers in the County's data center by replacing existing standalone servers with virtual servers and also using virtual servers in lieu of standalone servers for new workloads that are anticipated. The County has secured the services of various vendors for license and consulting purchases through existing contracts. The proposed purchase can be made immediately after funding becomes available. The project to move the current and anticipated servers to the virtual environment should be completed within 24 months.

The proposed project is consistent with activities outlined in B5.1 "actions to conserve energy"; therefore, it is categorically excluded from further NEPA review.
