Based on my review of the information concerning the proposed action, as NEPA Compliance Officer (authorized under DOE Order 451.1A), I have made the following determination:

## CX, EA, EIS APPENDIX AND NUMBER:

Description:

B5.1 Actions to conserve energy, demonstrate potential energy conservation, and promote energy-efficiency that do not increase the indoor concentrations of potentially harmful substances. These actions may involve financial and technical assistance to individuals (such as builders, owners, consultants, designers), organizations (such as utilities), and state and local governments. Covered actions include, but are not limited to: programmed lowering of thermostat settings, placement of timers on hot water heaters, installation of solar hot water systems, installation of efficient lighting, improvements in generator efficiency and appliance efficiency ratings, development of energy-efficient manufacturing or industrial practices, and small-scale conservation and renewable energy research and development and pilot projects. The actions could involve building renovations or new structures in commercial, residential, agricultural, or industrial sectors. These actions do not include rulemakings, standard-settings, or proposed DOE legislation.

## Rational for determination:

The Vermont Department of Education proposes to use federal funds to install 5kW solar photovoltaic systems at 10 school sites throughout the state. This NEPA review is to release funds conditioned on a previous NEPA review (GFO-09-139-001). Restriction was place on the release of funds for the State Historic Preservation Officer review of three schools where solar panels are to be installed.

The State Historic Preservation Officer letters have been received for Woodstock Middle/High School and Bellows Free Academy. A letter has not yet been received for The Sustainability Academy and therefore will continue to be restricted from installation in this NEPA review. An additional EF1 will need to be submitted for NEPA clearance of The Sustainability Academy.

The State Historic Preservation Officer has determined that Woodstock Middle/High School and Bellows Free Academy are not eligible for listing on the National Register of Historic Places due to building age. This concludes the NEPA review for these 2 schools; therefore a CX B5.1 will apply for the installation of solar panels.

DOE has made a conditional NEPA determination for this award, and funding for certain tasks under this award is contingent upon the final NEPA determination.
