Rational for determination:

Flint Geothermal LLC (Flint) would locate geothermal resources in Colorado by applying processed remote imaging data to search for geothermal resources, then more direct on-site methods (temperature gradient wells and slimholes) would be used to confirm the resource.

Phase I (Tasks 1 through 3) and Phase III – Task 12 (Task 10 of the present SOPO) of this project was previously approved by GFO-10-251 on April 7, 2010 with a CX A9. This NEPA determination is specific to Phase II – Task 4.

Phase II - Task 4:

The initial analyses of data collected in Phase I resulted in the selection of five broad potential geothermal resource areas to be further analyzed using geologic and geophysical surveys. Geological and geophysical surveys associated with this task may include stratigraphical and structural geology, faulting, chemical analysis, age of mineral deposits, surficial geothermal manifestations, magnetotelluric, and gravity.

Based on the results of the surveys conducted in Task 4, Flint would site multiple temperature gradient wells and two slim-holes to confirm the geothermal resource (Tasks 5 through 9). A future NEPA determination would be required prior to implementation of Task 5 through 9 activities.

Condition of Approval: Allowable - Phase II (Task 4); Prohibited - Phase II (Task 5) and Phase III (Tasks 6 through 9).

Phase II – Task 4 of this project is comprised of onsite geological and geophysical surveys. The DOE has categorized this proposal into Categorical Exclusion B3.1.
