Description:

- B3.6 Siting, construction (or modification), operation, and decommissioning of facilities for indoor bench-scale research projects and conventional laboratory operations (for example, preparation of chemical standards and sample analysis); small-scale research and development projects; and small-scale pilot projects (generally less than two years) conducted to verify a concept before demonstration actions. Construction (or modification) will be within or contiguous to an already developed area (where active utilities and currently used roads are readily accessible).
- B5.1 Actions to conserve energy, demonstrate potential energy conservation, and promote energy-efficiency that do not increase the indoor concentrations of potentially harmful substances. These actions may involve financial and technical assistance to individuals (such as builders, owners, consultants, designers), organizations (such as utilities), and state and local governments. Covered actions include, but are not limited to: programmed lowering of thermostat settings, placement of timers on hot water heaters, installation of solar hot water systems, installation of efficient lighting, improvements in generator efficiency and appliance efficiency ratings, development of energy-efficient manufacturing or industrial practices, and small-scale conservation and renewable energy research and development and pilot projects. Rational for determination:

Missouri DNR, Division of Energy's sub-recipient (Mississippi Lime) proposes to use SEP funding to replace an inefficient fan & housing system with a 3.000 horsepower induced drive fan. They will also install variable frequency drives on a fan and a mill currently controlled by a damper and an eddy clutch. These activities will take place at the Mississippi Lime Peerless Rotary Division facility in St Genevieve, MO.

SHPO:

The buildings these installations will take place were constructed between 1980 & 2006. These buildings do not meet the criterion for eligibility for listing on the National Register of Historic Places based on building age. The scope of work in this project also meets the appendix A, D. 1.a of the programmatic agreement between MO-DNR & MO-SHPO.

Waste:

The inefficient fan & eddy clutch will be removed and stored on site. The damper will remain in place. All construction debris will be handled as appropriate by the applicants contractors for installation.

Air:

These installations will not change the current air emissions of the plant. Mississippi Lime will not be required to modify or change the current air permit in place.

This project will include the installation of efficient equipment to conserve energy; therefore a CX B3.6 & B5.1 will apply.
