Based on my review of the information concerning the proposed action, as NEPA Compliance Officer (authorized under DOE Order 451.1A), I have made the following determination:

CX, EA, EIS APPENDIX AND NUMBER:

Description:

- Information gathering (including, but not limited to, literature surveys, inventories, audits), data analysis (including A9 computer modeling), document preparation (such as conceptual design or feasibility studies, analytical energy supply and demand studies), and dissemination (including, but not limited to, document mailings, publication, and distribution; and classroom training and informational programs), but not including site characterization or environmental monitoring.
- B3.1 Onsite and offsite site characterization and environmental monitoring, including siting, construction (or modification), operation, and dismantlement or closing (abandonment) of characterization and monitoring devices and siting, construction, and associated operation of a small-scale laboratory building or renovation of a room in an existing building for sample analysis. Activities covered include, but are not limited to, site characterization and environmental monitoring under CERCLA and RCRA. Specific activities include, but are not limited to:
- B3.6 Siting, construction (or modification), operation, and decommissioning of facilities for indoor bench-scale research projects and conventional laboratory operations (for example, preparation of chemical standards and sample analysis); small-scale research and development projects; and small-scale pilot projects (generally less than two years) conducted to verify a concept before demonstration actions. Construction (or modification) will be within or contiguous to an already developed area (where active utilities and currently used roads are readily accessible).

Rational for determination:

Nevada Geothermal Power Co. (NGP) would apply highly detailed, precise, low cost subsoil and down-hole gas geochemistry methods from the oil and gas industry to identify two upflow zone slim hole drilling targets in an undeveloped geothermal prospect at Pumpernickel Valley, Nevada.

Phase 1 - Exploration Geochemistry

- 1.0 Perform Biological and Cultural Resource Surveys and Obtain Permits
- 2.0 Sub-soil Gas Survey
- 2.1 Perform 2 m probe chemical survey over thermal anomaly This task requires an approved Notice of Intent (NOI) from the Bureau of Land Management (BLM)
- 2.2 Analyze hydrocarbons, isotopes, and gas samples
- 2.3 Interpret chemical distributions
- 3.0 Target deep slim holes

As the locations of the two slim hole wells have yet to be determined, Phase 2 (Tasks 4.0 through 10.0) of the project cannot be analyzed at this time. All Phase 2 activities (except Task 11.0 Project Management and Reporting) are subject to additional NEPA review prior to DOE authorizing funding.

Phase 2 - Drilling

- 4.0 Upgrade roads and build well locations
- 5.0 Drill a deep slim hole
- 6.0 Test well; collect and analyze fluids and cuttings from slim hole
- 6.1 Fluid Inclusion Stratigraphy
- 6.2 Gas, liquid, and isotope analyses
- 7.0 Geochemical Re-interpretation
- 8.0 Re-evaluate second drill target
- 9.0 Drill second deep slim hole
- 10.0 Test well (s); collect and analyze fluids and cuttings from slim hole

Task 11.0 Project Management and Reporting

This NEPA determination applies to Phase 1 and Task 11.0 only. Further, Phase 1 - Task 2.1 is contingent upon receiving the NOI from the BLM prior to DOE authorizing funding.

Phase 1 and Phase 2 (Task 11.0) of this project are comprised of information gathering, data analysis, document preparation; onsite site characterization activities; and conventional laboratory operations; therefore the DOE has categorized this proposal into Categorical Exclusions A9, B3.1, and B3.6.

Note: Prior to this NEPA determination, a Limited Release of Funds was authorized via STRIPES req 10EE003281 under a Blanket CX.

NEPA PROVISION

DOE has made a conditional NEPA determination for this award, and funding for certain tasks under this award is contingent upon the final NEPA determination.
