Based on my review of the information concerning the proposed action, as NEPA Compliance Officer (authorized under DOE Order 451.1A), I have made the following determination:

CX, EA, EIS APPENDIX AND NUMBER:

Description:

B5.1 Actions to conserve energy, demonstrate potential energy conservation, and promote energy-efficiency that do not increase the indoor concentrations of potentially harmful substances. These actions may involve financial and technical assistance to individuals (such as builders, owners, consultants, designers), organizations (such as utilities), and state and local governments. Covered actions include, but are not limited to: programmed lowering of thermostat settings, placement of timers on hot water heaters, installation of solar hot water systems, installation of efficient lighting, improvements in generator efficiency and appliance efficiency ratings, development of energy-efficient manufacturing or industrial practices, and small-scale conservation and renewable energy research and development and pilot projects. The actions could involve building renovations or new structures in commercial, residential, agricultural, or industrial sectors. These actions do not include rulemakings, standard-settings, or proposed DOE legislation.

Rational for determination:

Missouri DNR, Division of Energy's sub-recipient Bodine Aluminum Inc. proposes to use \$750,000 of SEP ARRA funds to replace the existing Thermal Oxidizer system with a larger, more efficient Regenerative Thermal Oxidizer system. The new system is expected to save 11,474 MMBTU's and abate Volatile Organic Compounds (VOC) and odors. No building modifications would be required with the replacement/installation of the new oxidizer because the proposed project would be utilizing existing holes and piping.

The installation of the new Regenerative Thermal Oxidizer would have no adverse impacts to floodplains, wetlands, and endangered species, as this project entails internal activities at an existing facility.

Air permit modification was submitted on March 15, 2011 to the Missouri DNR Air Division. Emissions (VOCs) associated with this project would be reduced by 3,460 lbs per year. At the maximum permitted level, VOCs would be reduced by 17,900 lbs per year.

Waste materials associated with this project would be taken to a licensed landfill and recycle facility.

The Missouri Department of Natural Resources, State Historic Preservation Office (SHPO) performed a cultural resource assessment. In a letter dated 6.27.2011, Deputy SHPO Mark Miles determined no historic properties would be affected by the proposed project.

In view of the information provided by the recipient, DOE has determined that the impacts related to the proposed project are anticipated to have negligible affects on the human and natural environment. The proposed project is consistent with actions outlined in B5.1, "actions to conserve energy," and is, therefore, categorically excluded from further NEPA review.
