Description:

Trenching will occur for the installation of electric supply lines from the municipal building to both charging stations. The trenching will follow the edge of the paved parking area. This area is previously disturbed and will not impact cultural resources. Furthermore impacts to air, water, and endangered species/critical habitat are not expected to occur as a result of this project.

This project is comprised of actions to conserve energy through implementing electric vehicle technologies; therefore a CX B5.1 will apply.
