Based on my review of the information concerning the proposed action, as NEPA Compliance Officer (authorized under DOE Order 451.1A), I have made the following determination:

Description:

- A9 Information gathering (including, but not limited to, literature surveys, inventories, audits), data analysis (including computer modeling), document preparation (such as conceptual design or feasibility studies, analytical energy supply and demand studies), and dissemination (including, but not limited to, document mailings, publication, and distribution; and classroom training and informational programs), but not including site characterization or environmental monitoring.
- B5.1 Actions to conserve energy, demonstrate potential energy conservation, and promote energy-efficiency that do not increase the indoor concentrations of potentially harmful substances. These actions may involve financial and technical assistance to individuals (such as builders, owners, consultants, designers), organizations (such as utilities), and state and local governments. Covered actions include, but are not limited to: programmed lowering of thermostat settings, placement of timers on hot water heaters, installation of solar hot water systems, installation of efficient lighting, improvements in generator efficiency and appliance efficiency ratings, development of energy-efficient manufacturing or industrial practices, and small-scale conservation and renewable energy research and development and pilot projects. The actions could involve building renovations or new structures in commercial, residential, agricultural, or industrial sectors. These actions do not include rulemakings, standard-settings, or proposed DOE legislation.

Rational for determination:

DOE is proposing to provide federal funding to the Town of Dedham to install roof-mounted solar PV panels on the Town Hall and High School.

The Town of Dedham would install a 50 kW system on the roof of the Dedham Town Hall located at 26 Bryant Street. Dedham, MA 02026. The Dedham Town Hall was built in 1961. The system would cover forty percent of the roof. The building is approximately 17,430 square feet with a flat, rubber roof, which is twenty years old. The roof is in poor condition and would be replaced with a highly reflective or white surface prior to the PV system installation. The Town of Dedham would also install an educational kiosk that monitors the system on the Town Hall for residents and visitors to view the energy savings produced by the panels.

On August 16, 2011, the Massachusetts Historical Commission concurred with DOE's determination of "no adverse affect to historic properties as a result of the proposed project."

The Town of Dedham would also install a 129 KW system on the roof of the High School located at 140 Whiting Ave, Dedham, MA 02026. The High School was built in 1970. The solar panels on this structure would cover the roof section of the auditorium, gym and auto shop. The roof is flat, unobstructed and structurally sound.

The proposed project locations are not in a wetland or floodplain, nor are threatened and endangered species known to occur in the area.

Based on this information, DOE has determined that the work outlined is consistent with activities identified in Categorical Exclusion A9 (information gathering) and B5.1 (actions to conserve energy).
