Based on my review of the information concerning the proposed action, as NEPA Compliance Officer (authorized under DOE Order 451.1A), I have made the following determination:

Description:

A9 Information gathering, analysis, and dissemination

Information gathering (including, but not limited to, literature surveys, inventories, site visits, and audits), data analysis (including, but not limited to, computer modeling), document preparation (including, but not limited to, conceptual design, feasibility studies, and analytical energy supply and demand studies), and information dissemination (including, but not limited to, document publication and distribution, and classroom training and informational programs), but not including site characterization or environmental monitoring. (See also B3.1 of appendix B to this subpart.)

## Rational for determination:

Percheron Power, LLC is proposing to use DOE funds to design, permit, install, and operate a small low-head hydroelectric generation facility in an existing engineered water drop within the Columbia Basin Project. It will employ a new type of turbine and technology, called an Archimedes Hydrodynamic Screw (AHS), to harness the existing potential of the engineered drop.

Projects tasks are divided into two budget periods (BP). This determination is being conducted for BP1 activities only. BP2 activities are dependent on successful completion of Tasks 1 and 2 and would require additional NEPA review and DOE authorization to continue after a Go/No go decision.

Budget periods and tasks are as follows:

**Budget Period 1** 

Task 1: Licensing/Permitting Task 2: Design (preliminary)

**Budget Period 2** 

Task 3: Construction/Installation on Site Task 4: Testing and Commissioning

Task 5: Project Management and Reporting (both budget periods)

During BP1, DOE funding would be used to support feasibility assessments, preliminary design, stakeholder and agency interaction, permitting and licensing. The second phase (Tasks 3 and 4) of the project would be performed only upon successful receipt of the FERC license and DOE's decision to fund BP2.

Based on this information, DOE has determined that Tasks 1, 2 and Task 5 are consistent with activities identified in categorical exclusion A9 (Information gathering data analysis, conceptual design, and computer modeling).

## NEPA PROVISION

DOE has made a conditional NEPA determination for this award, and funding for certain tasks under this award is contingent upon the final NEPA determination.
