Description:

Information gathering (including, but not limited to, literature surveys, inventories, site visits, and gathering, analysis, audits), data analysis (including, but not limited to, computer modeling), document preparation (including, but not limited to, conceptual design, feasibility studies, and analytical energy supply and demand studies), and information dissemination (including, but not limited to, document publication and distribution, and classroom training and informational programs), but not including site characterization or environmental monitoring. Rational for determination:

DOE adopted the U.S. Department of Agriculture Amended Environmental Assessment for the Rainier Biogas Community Anaerobic Digester (DOE EA-1832) and issued a Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) that authorized the expenditure of federal funding through the State Energy Program to Rainier Biogas LLC to support the final design, construction, and initial operation of its Community Aneorobic Manure Digester (CAMD) project and decommissioning of the facility in Enumclaw, King County, Washington.

This project will be constructed on property provided by Ritter Dairy, LLC in Enumclaw, Washington. It consists of a manure receiving system, an anaerobic digester, gas handling system, an engine-generator unit and disgested solids processing and recycling systems. Participating dairies will deliver manure to the project by pipe or truck. The manure will be processed in an anaerobic digester which will produce biogas, recyclable solids products and processed manure liquid. The biogas will be delivered to an engine generator to produce electricity that will be sold to the local utility. This project will generate about 6000 MWh per year of renewable electricity. DOE is now proposing to provide federal funding (Congressionally Directed Project) to King County Department of Natural Resources and to Rainier Biogas, LLC (grant sub-recipient) for permitting; contracting and procurement; construction; operation; and monitoring and reporting.

The proposed project is within the project scope analyzed in DOE EA-1832 and FONSI and consistent with actions outlined in A9 (information gathering).
