## Rational for determination:

The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) provided \$562,000 of federal funding to the State of Maryland under the DOE's Annually Appropriated State Energy Program (SEP) for 2012. Maryland will match the federal funding with \$112,400 in state funds, for a total of \$674,400.

Maryland proposes to fund the following Market Titles:

Planning and Administration:

Under this Market Title, Maryland would use funding to provide energy policy and direction, redesign the Maryland Energy Administration website, and identify, coordinate and develop energy programs within the State.

Based on a review of the activity that would be funded under the above Market Title, DOE has determined the project that would be funded under these Market Title will not significantly impact the human environment and they is categorically excluded from further NEPA review under CX A9 "information gathering," and CX A11 "technical advice."
