Rational for determination:

The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) provided \$666,000 of federal funding to Minnesota State Energy Office (SEO) under the DOE's Annually Appropriated State Energy Program (SEP) for 2012. The SEO will match the federal funding with \$133,200 in state funds and will carry over \$1,022,205 for a total of \$1,821,405.

The SEO proposes to fund the following Market Titles:

SEP Administration:

Information and Outreach:

Renewable Projects

Under this Market Title, the SEO would use federal funding to continue to provide technical assistance to consumers, businesses, and policy makers on renewable energy and clean fuels resources, policies and technologies; serve on various renewable energy boards; administer the ongoing Minnesota Renewable Energy Production Incentive program; and continue effort to increase distributed generation in the state.
