Based on my review of the information concerning the proposed action, as NEPA Compliance Officer (authorized under DOE Order 451.1A), I have made the following determination:

Description:

A9 Information gathering, analysis, and dissemination Information gathering (including, but not limited to, literature surveys, inventories, site visits, and audits), data analysis (including, but not limited to, computer modeling), document preparation (including, but not limited to, conceptual design, feasibility studies, and analytical energy supply and demand studies), and information dissemination (including, but not limited to, document publication and distribution, and classroom training and informational programs), but not including site characterization or environmental monitoring. A11 Technical advice and assistance to organizations Technical advice and planning assistance to international, national, state, and local organizations.

Rational for determination:

The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) provided \$193,000 of federal funding to the State of Wyoming under the DOE's Annually Appropriated State Energy Program (SEP) for 2012. Wyoming will match the federal funding with \$46,561.48 in state funds, \$703,757 in Exxon Funds and \$20,000 in Stripper Well. Additionally, Wyoming will carry over \$35,000 in federal appropriations, for a total of \$998,318.48.

Wyoming proposes to fund the following Market Titles:

Program Support:

Under this Market Title, Wyoming would use funding to support the continuing operation of the SEP activities performed by Wyoming personnel.

Public Information/Messaging and Outreach:

Under this Market Title, Wyoming would increase awareness of energy efficiency through "Wyoming Energy Wise." Outreach efforts would also include the development and display of project profiles on the State Energy Office website.

Residential Revolving Loan Program:

Under this Market Title, the Revolving Loan Program, funded with appropriations from the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act, would be monitored through funding provided for the Program Support Market Title. The NEPA Template was signed for this Market Title, any projects that fall outside the bounded categories of the NEPA Template will be submitted for NEPA review.

Based on a review of the activities that would be funded under the above Market Titles, DOE has determined the projects that would be funded under these Market Titles will not significantly impact the human environment and they are categorically excluded from further NEPA review under CX A9 "information gathering," and CX A11 "technical advice." Any activities funded by the Revolving Loan Program that fall outside the bounds of Wyoming's Template for Expedited NEPA review are conditioned pending additional NEPA review.

NEPA PROVISION

DOE has made a conditional NEPA determination for this award, and funding for certain tasks under this award is contingent upon the final NEPA determination.

Insert the following language in the award:

You are restricted from taking any action using federal funds, which would have an adverse affect on the environment or limit the choice of reasonable alternatives prior to DOE/NNSA providing either a NEPA clearance or a final NEPA decision regarding the project.

Prohibited actions include:

Any activities funded by the revolving loan programs that fall outside the bounds of Wyoming's Template for Expedited NEPA review are conditioned pending additional NEPA review.

Any activities funded under the 2012 annual appropriations that involve ground-breaking activities, retrofits, or equipment purchase and/or installation are conditioned pending additional NEPA review.

This restriction does not preclude you from:

Activities involving administrative actions, technical advice, education and outreach.

If you move forward with activities that are not authorized for federal funding by the DOE Contracting Officer in advance of the final NEPA decision, you are doing so at risk of not receiving federal funding and such costs may not be recognized as allowable cost share.
