Based on my review of the information concerning the proposed action, as NEPA Compliance Officer (authorized under DOE Order 451.1A), I have made the following determination:

Description:

B5.23 Electric vehicle charging stations The installation, modification, operation, and removal of electric vehicle charging stations, using commercially available technology, within a previously disturbed or developed area. Covered actions are limited to areas where access and parking are in accordance with applicable requirements (such as local land use and zoning requirements) in the proposed project area and would incorporate appropriate control technologies and best management practices.

Rational for determination:

The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) provided funding to the City of Honolulu, Hawaii under the DOE's American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grant Program (EECBG). Honolulu proposes to use \$8,000 to install one electric vehicle charging station.

The proposed project would install a level two electric vehicle charging station at Halawa Corporation Yard, located at 99-999 Iwaena Street, Aiea, Hawaii 96701 on the rooftop parking deck of Building D. Halawa Yard is a City public works facility. The proposed project would utilize an existing electrical disconnect switch and conduit from a previously removed charging station. The proposed charging station would not include any new trenching or wiring. City employees would utilize the charging station for the two electric vehicles in the fleet.

The proposed project would not have adverse effects on threatened and endangered species, wetlands, floodplains, or cultural resources, as these resources are not known to occur at the proposed sites. SHPO provided a determination of no adverse effect to historic properties.

Based on review of project information and the above analysis, DOE has determined that the installation of the proposed electric vehicle charging station would not have a significant individual or cumulative impact to human health and/or environment. DOE has determined the proposed charging station is consistent with the actions contained in DOE categorical exclusion B5.23 "Electric vehicle charging stations" and is categorically excluded from further NEPA review

Any further projects will require a separate NEPA determination review.
