Rational for determination:

The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) provided \$286,000 of federal funding to the State of New Mexico under the DOE's Annually Appropriated State Energy Program (SEP) for 2012. New Mexico will match the federal funding with \$151,825 in state funds. Additionally, New Mexico will carryover \$321,300 in federal appropriations, for a total of \$759,125.

New Mexico proposes to fund the following Market Titles:

SEP Program Administration:

Under this Market Title, funding would be used to support the continuing operation of the SEP activities performed by New Mexico Energy Office personnel.

Energy Efficiency & Renewable Energy/Building:

Under this Market Title, New Mexico would collaborate with state, local and tribal agencies, and schools to develop an implementation strategy; determine procurement processes; develop audit specifications; contractual agreements with selected agencies, schools and contractors; and prepare the annual report.

Based on a review of the activities that would be funded under the above Market Titles, DOE has determined the projects that would be funded under these Market Titles will not significantly impact the human environment and they are categorically excluded from further NEPA review under CX A9 "information gathering," and CX A11 "technical
