Description:

**A9 Information gathering, analysis, and dissemination** Information gathering (including, but not limited to, literature surveys, inventories, site visits, and audits), data analysis (including, but not limited to, computer modeling), document preparation (including, but not limited to, conceptual design, feasibility studies, and analytical energy supply and demand studies), and information dissemination (including, but not limited to, document publication and distribution, and classroom training and informational programs), but not including site characterization or environmental monitoring. (See also B3.1 of appendix B to this subpart.)

**A11 Technical advice and assistance to organizations** Technical advice and planning assistance to international, national, state, and local organizations.

**Rational for determination:**

The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) provided \$414,000 of federal funding to the state of South Carolina (SC) under the DOE's Annually Appropriated State Energy Program (SEP) for 2012. SC will match the federal funding with \$362,000 in state funds. Additionally, SC will carry over \$142,611.89 in Recovery Act SEP funds.

SC proposes to fund the following market titles:

**Buildings:**

Under this Market Title, SC would use federal funding for staff support and program administration, as well as providing educational workshops and limited travel. One renewable energy demonstration project would be funded by this market title. Upon selection, this project will be submitted for additional NEPA review and is conditioned pending a final NEPA review and determination.

**Industrial Energy Efficiency and Renewable Energy:**

Under this Market Title, SC would use federal funding for contractual services for workshops.

**Operations, Strategic Planning, and Emergency Preparedness:**

Under this Market Title, SC would use federal funding for staff support for data review, technical assistance, website maintenance, State Energy Emergency Plan activities, and supplies.

**Public Information and Outreach:**

Under this Market Title, SC would use federal funding for informational presentations to the public.

**Renewable Energy Market Development:**

Under this Market Title, SC would use federal funding for participation in various local technology councils, providing information to the public, and administering other energy programs.

**Transportation Energy Efficiency, Conservation, and Alternative Fuels:**

Under this Market Title, SC would use federal funding for providing information to the public, technical assistance, data collection, and other administrative activities.

SC would also continue to administer its two Recovery Act-funded financing programs: Energy Retrofits and Energy Efficiency Loan Fund. Both programs were previously CX'd.

Based on a review of the activities that would be funded under the above Market Titles, DOE has determined the

projects that would be funded under these Market Titles will not significantly impact the human environment and they are categorically excluded from further NEPA review under CX A9 "information gathering" and CX A11 "technical advice." Any activities funded under the 2012 annual appropriations that involve ground-breaking activities, retrofits, or equipment purchase and/or installation are conditioned pending additional NEPA review.

**NEPA PROVISION**

DOE has made a conditional NEPA determination for this award, and funding for certain tasks under this award is contingent upon the final NEPA determination.

Insert the following language in the award:

You are restricted from taking any action using federal funds, which would have an adverse affect on the environment or limit the choice of reasonable alternatives prior to DOE/NNSA providing either a NEPA clearance or a final NEPA decision regarding the project.

Prohibited actions include:

Buildings Market Title:

Upon selection, the renewable energy demonstration project will be submitted for additional NEPA review and is conditioned pending a final NEPA review and determination.

This restriction does not preclude you from:

If you move forward with activities that are not authorized for federal funding by the DOE Contracting Officer in advance of the final NEPA decision, you are doing so at risk of not receiving federal funding and such costs may not be recognized as allowable cost share.

Insert the following language in the award:

You are required to:

Any activities funded under the 2012 annual appropriations that involve ground-breaking activities, retrofits, or equipment purchase and/or installation are conditioned pending additional NEPA review.
