Description:

- A9 Information gathering, analysis, and dissemination** Information gathering (including, but not limited to, literature surveys, inventories, site visits, and audits), data analysis (including, but not limited to, computer modeling), document preparation (including, but not limited to, conceptual design, feasibility studies, and analytical energy supply and demand studies), and information dissemination (including, but not limited to, document publication and distribution, and classroom training and informational programs), but not including site characterization or environmental monitoring. (See also B3.1 of appendix B to this subpart.)
- A11 Technical advice and assistance to organizations** Technical advice and planning assistance to international, national, state, and local organizations.

Rational for determination:

The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) provided \$342,500 of federal funding to the state of Montana (MT) under the DOE's Annually Appropriated State Energy Program (SEP) for 2012. MT will provide \$68,500 in state match.

MT proposes to fund the following market titles:

Education and Outreach:

Under this Market Title, MT would use federal funding to develop and update information on energy efficiency technologies to distribute to state and local governments and to the public.

Renewable Energy and Technical Assistance:

Under this Market Title, MT would use federal funding to promote and support the development of wind, solar, geothermal and hydroelectric resources.

SEP Program Administration:

Under this Market Title, MT would use federal funding to administer and supervise its SEP.

State Energy Planning:

Under this Market Title, MT would use federal funding to study MT's energy sectors including electricity, electric transmission, natural gas, coal and petroleum. In addition, statistics on those systems would be compiled and the "Understanding Energy in Montana" publication would be updated.

Alternative Energy Renewable Loan Program:

Under this Market Title, MT would continue to use federal funding for a revolving loan fund that would finance cost-effective energy efficiency improvements in private and public facilities. This Market Title has been previously CX'd from further NEPA review. Any projects funded under this Market Title that do not remain within the bounds of MT's Template for Expedited NEPA Review will be submitted for additional NEPA review.

State Buildings Energy Conservation Program Revolving Fund:

Under this Market Title, MT would continue to use federal funding for a revolving loan fund that would finance cost-effective audits and energy efficiency improvements in state buildings. This Market Title has been previously CX'd from further NEPA review. Any projects funded under this Market Title that do not remain within the bounds of MT's Template for Expedited NEPA Review will be submitted for additional NEPA review.

Based on a review of the activities that would be funded under the above Market Titles, DOE has determined the

projects that would be funded under these Market Titles will not significantly impact the human environment and they are categorically excluded from further NEPA review under CX A9 "information gathering" and CX A11 "technical advice." Any activities funded under the 2012 annual appropriations that involve ground-breaking activities, retrofits, or equipment purchase and/or installation are conditioned pending additional NEPA review.
