Department for Energy Development and Independence (DEDI) Program Management, Policy Development and Energy Security:

Under this Market Title, Kentucky would develop energy policies, manage State Energy Program contracts and subgrants, Energy Star and special projects, and produce complex econometric models for quantitative analysis of energy and economic statistics supporting energy policy and program design, implementation and evaluation.

University of Kentucky Cooperative Extension Service (CES):
