Under Activity # 5, Capital Improvement Projects, the City would increase the scope of work to include solar pathway lighting and solar reflective coating for the City Hall's Orchard Parking lot.

DOE made previous NEPA determinations: (3/10/2010 CX A9, A11, B5.1, 3/14/2013 CX B5.1, B5.16, B5.18, B5.23) which included Activity #5.
