Rationale for determination:

The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) is proposing to provide federal funding to the Mid-America Regional Council (MARC) to expand collaborative approach of the 2012 Solar Ready KC initiative to a national scale, using established relationships among regional planning councils and their member local governments. The recipient would work with local and state governmental agencies to adopt solar-friendly best management practices.
