A9 Information and dissemination

Information gathering (including, but not limited to, literature surveys, inventories, site visits, and gathering, analysis, audits), data analysis (including, but not limited to, computer modeling), document preparation (including, but not limited to, conceptual design, feasibility studies, and analytical energy supply and demand studies), and information dissemination (including, but not limited to, document publication and distribution, and classroom training and informational programs), but not including site characterization or environmental monitoring. ## Rationale for determination:

The U.S. Department of energy is proposing to provide federal funding to Electric Power Research Institute to assess the operational and business impacts posed by high levels of solar generation and assist the development of strategic plans that ensure solar system reliability and utility financial health related to these levels of solar generation. This information will be gathered by traditional desktop studies then disseminated publically. Activities would involve data collection and analysis, materials development, program design and computer modeling.
