Description:

A9 Information gathering, analysis, and dissemination

Information gathering (including, but not limited to, literature surveys, inventories, site visits, and audits), data analysis (including, but not limited to, computer modeling), document preparation (including, but not limited to, conceptual design, feasibility studies, and analytical energy supply and demand studies), and information dissemination (including, but not limited to, document publication and distribution, and classroom training and informational programs), but not including site characterization or environmental monitoring. A11 Technical advice and assistance to organizations

Technical advice and planning assistance to international, national, state, and local organizations.

B3.6 Small-scale research and development, and pilot projects

Siting, construction, modification, operation, and decommissioning of facilities for smallscale research and development projects; conventional laboratory operations (such as preparation of chemical standards and sample analysis); and small-scale pilot projects (generally less than 2 years) laboratory operations, frequently conducted to verify a concept before demonstration actions, provided that construction or modification would be within or contiguous to a previously disturbed or developed area (where active utilities and currently used roads are readily accessible). Not included in this category are demonstration actions, meaning actions that are undertaken at a scale to show whether a technology would be viable on a larger scale and suitable for commercial deployment.

Rationale for determination:

The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) is proposing to provide federal funding to Pepco Holdings Inc., to coordinate and standardize a number of critical and innovative design, control, analysis and data management capabilities with a focus on making high penetrations of photovoltaic a fully integrated part of utility strategic planning, operations management and supervisory level monitoring and control practices. DOE funding would be used for modeling software to simulate voltage regulation solutions for distribution feeders. Some field demonstration work would occur in which automatic line equipment settings are adjusted and possibly moved to more ideal locations on distribution feeders. All equipment adjustments or modifications would be minor in scope and occur within existing facilities.

This award would accelerate PV maturity at electric CoOps through standard designs, insurance, financing and training. DOE funds and cost share will not be used for purchasing PV equipment and/or PV deployments. The funds would be used to provide technical designs, models, technical assistance, and training specific to PV deployments funded by electric cooperatives that plan to provide partial cost share to the project. Prime and sub-recipients including participating cooperatives are restricted from using federal funds under this FOA to purchase PV hardware. equipment, or pay for labor, or installations.

Based on review of the project information and the above analysis, DOE has determined the information gathering and technical advice activities would not have a significant individual or cumulative impact to human health and/or environment. DOE has determined the proposed project is consistent with the actions contained in DOE categorical exclusions A9 "information gathering, analysis, and dissemination," A11 "technical advice and assistance to organizations," and B3.6 "small-scale research and development," and is categorically excluded from further NEPA review.
