Description:

A9 Information and dissemination

Information gathering (including, but not limited to, literature surveys, inventories, site visits, and gathering, analysis, audits), data analysis (including, but not limited to, computer modeling), document preparation (including, but not limited to, conceptual design, feasibility studies, and analytical energy supply and demand studies), and information dissemination (including, but not limited to, document publication and distribution, and classroom training and informational programs), but not including site characterization or environmental monitoring. ## Rationale for determination:

The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) is proposing to provide federal funding to Oregon State University (OSU) to plan and conduct feasibility studies to assist in the development of a future offshore wave energy technology testing

DOE funding would be used to evaluate and validate the facility siting, preliminary design, construction and operational requirements and device testing and performance certification/validation opportunities. Specifically, OSU would conduct analytical desktop studies to advance planning parameters for a future "Ocean Test Facility". These actions include developing preliminary facility designs; developing the estimated cost and site construction schedule: estimating the annual operating costs for the facility; and determining the appropriate testing fees that would be required for a full cost recovery.

DOE has determined that this project is consistent with actions covered under DOE CX A9 (Information gathering and data analysis, including literature surveys, inventories, and observational site visits) and that no extraordinary circumstances related to the project work would significantly affect the human and natural environment; and therefore is categorically excluded from further NEPA review.
