Based on my review of the information concerning the proposed action, as NEPA Compliance Officer (authorized under DOE Policy 451.1), I have made the following determination:

Rationale for determination:

The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) is proposing to provide federal funding to Dane County, Wisconsin for the retrofit of windows and lighting, integration of lighting and HVAC controls, testing of demand response, measurement and verification of building system performance impacts, and surveying occupants and operators at one public sector building in Madison, WI.

Activities associated with Budget Period 1 (BP1) of the proposed project would include retrofit design and pre-retrofit measurement and verification (M&V). M&V equipment setup and installation would occur at the public sector building but no building modifications would be required. No health, safety or environmental impacts associated with BP1 activities are anticipated.

There would be a Go/No-Go decision point at the end of BP1. Results of BP1 activities would define and inform the remainder of the project activities therefore potential impacts associated with the remaining project activities are not defined and cannot be reviewed at this time. Further NEPA review will be required prior to moving forward with BP2 and BP3 activities.
