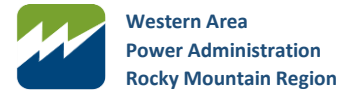


CATEGORICAL EXCLUSION DETERMINATION



Proposed Action Title: Thermopolis-Boysen 115-kV Transmission Line Emergency Structure Repair and Access Road Maintenance

Location: Fremont County, Wyoming

Project Number: 2021-075

Expiration Date: July 31, 2021

A. PROPOSED ACTION DESCRIPTION:

Western Area Power Administration (WAPA), Rocky Mountain Region (RMR), completed emergency structure repair, landing pad construction, and access road maintenance for Structures 13/3 to 13/5 on the Thermopolis-Boysen (TH-B) 115-kV Transmission Line, in Fremont County, Wyoming. This emergency maintenance was necessary to facilitate safe access for emergency transmission line crossarm repairs following storm damage sustained on May 22, 2021. New access roads to structures 13/4 and 13/5 were constructed. Access road maintenance included blading; grading; and removal of rocks, vegetation and other obstacles impeding safe travels. Equipment used for the project included ATVs/UTVs, bulldozers, excavators, skid-steer loaders, trackhoes, utility trucks and equipment trailer. Work occurred on WAPA's existing access roads and within the right-of-way (ROW) on private lands and on the Wind River Indian Reservation.

B. STIPULATIONS PERTAINING TO PROPOSAL:

This Categorical Exclusion (CX) covers work that has already been completed. No further work is authorized under this CX. If additional work is required, RMR's Environment Department must be contacted to determine whether additional environmental review is required.

D. REGULATORY REQUIREMENTS 10 CFR 1021.410 (b): (See full text in regulation)

The proposed action fits within a class of actions that is listed in Appendix A or B of 10 CFR 1021.

To fit within the classes of actions listed in Appendix B, a proposal must be one that would not:
(1) threaten a violation of applicable statutory, regulatory, or permit requirements for environment, safety, and health, or similar requirements of the Department of Energy (DOE) or Executive Orders;
(2) require siting and construction or major expansion of waste storage, disposal, recovery, or treatment facilities (including incinerators), but the proposal may include categorically excluded

waste storage, disposal, recovery, or treatment actions or facilities; (3) disturb hazardous substances; pollutants; contaminants; or Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act (CERCLA)-excluded petroleum and natural gas products that preexist in the environment such that there would be uncontrolled or unpermitted releases; (4) have the potential to cause significant impacts on environmentally sensitive resources, including, but not limited to, those listed in paragraph B(4) of 10 CFR 1021, Subpart D, Appendix B; (5) involve genetically engineered organisms, synthetic biology, governmentally designated noxious weeds, or invasive species, unless the proposed activity would be contained or confined in a manner designed and operated to prevent unauthorized release into the environment and conducted in accordance with applicable requirements, such as those of the Department of Agriculture, the Environmental Protection Agency, and the National Institutes of Health.

There are no extraordinary circumstances related to the proposal that may affect the significance of the environmental effects of the proposal.

The proposal has not been improperly segmented, and the proposal is not connected to other actions with potentially significant impacts, is not related to other proposed actions with cumulatively significant impacts, and is not precluded by 40 CFR 1506.1 or 10 CFR 1021.211.

E. DETERMINATION:

Based on my review of information conveyed to me and in my possession (or attached) concerning the proposed action, as NEPA Compliance Officer (as authorized under DOE Order 451.1B), I have determined that the proposed action fits within the specified class(es) of action, the other regulatory requirements set forth above are met, and the proposed action is hereby categorically excluded from further NEPA review.
