Covered actions would be in accordance with applicable requirements (such as local land use and zoning requirements) in the proposed project area and would incorporate appropriate control technologies and best management practices.

## Rationale for determination:

The U.S. Department of Energy is proposing to provide funding to Imagen Energy, LLC (Imagen) design, develop, fabricate and test a 1MW photovoltaic inverter. The project would take place over two Budget Periods with a go/nogo decision before the second budget period.

During budget period Imagen would develop and test subsystem hardware, complete a cost analysis, and engage stakeholders. During the second budget period Imagen would complete system integration, full system testing, regulatory evaluation and continue stakeholder engagement. The design, development, and fabrication activities would occur at Imagen's research facility in Wauwatosa, WI. The full system testing would be done at University of South Carolina engineering lab at the University of Arkansas.

All work would be completed at existing, purpose-built facilities following applicable health and safety policies and procedures. No modifications to existing facilities would be required. There is no field testing proposed. DOE does not anticipate adverse impacts to any resources of concern as a result of this project.
