Activities involved would include software development and investment in broader organizational resources including non-technical support staff and hardware upgrades. The proposed project would be limited to academic and/or or analytical activities.

Based on review of the project information and the above analysis, DOE has determined the proposed project would not have a significant individual or cumulative impact to human health and/or environment.
