Description:

A9 Information gathering, analysis, and dissemination

Information gathering (including, but not limited to, literature surveys, inventories, site visits, and audits), data analysis (including, but not limited to, computer modeling), document preparation (including, but not limited to, conceptual design, feasibility studies, and analytical energy supply and demand studies), and information dissemination (including, but not limited to, document publication and distribution, and classroom training and informational programs), but not including site characterization or environmental monitoring. B3.6 Small-scale research and development, and pilot projects

Siting, construction, modification, operation, and decommissioning of facilities for smallscale research and development projects; conventional laboratory operations (such as preparation of chemical standards and sample analysis); and small-scale pilot projects (generally less than 2 years) laboratory operations, frequently conducted to verify a concept before demonstration actions, provided that construction or modification would be within or contiguous to a previously disturbed or developed area (where active utilities and currently used roads are readily accessible). Not included in this category are demonstration actions, meaning actions that are undertaken at a scale to show whether a technology would be viable on a larger scale and suitable for commercial deployment.

Rationale for determination:

SRI International (SRI) would utilize DOE and cost share funding to synthesize and test new ion exchange resins for the separation of lithium and manganese from geothermal fluids. Project work would be performed in SRI's laboratories in Menlo Park, California. Additional testing would be performed by Simbol Materials in their laboratories in Pleasanton, California. The proposed project is a standalone effort and is not connected to a larger project. Project work occurring at each facility would conform to existing facility usage with no new permits needed for project work. All facilities have existing health and safety policies in place for the anticipated project work. Each facility has dedicated hazardous material handling and disposal practices for geothermal brines and all hazardous materials would be managed in accordance with federal, state, and local environmental regulations.

Based on review of the project information, DOE has determined that project activities would not have a significant individual or cumulative impact to human health and/or the environment. DOE has determined that these activities are consistent with actions contained in DOE categorical exclusions A9 "Information gathering, analysis, and dissemination," and B3.6 "Small-scale research and development, laboratory operations, and pilot projects," and are categorically excluded from further NEPA review.
