Description:

Rationale for determination:

DOE is proposing to provide funding to Solar Grid Storage LLC (Solar Grid) to design, procure, and install software and equipment to establish a new Solar Storage Operations Center (SSOC). The proposed project would entail developing the software, procuring the software system components and installing the software components at five (5) sites with existing solar PV systems.

The proposed project would involve the operation and connection of various software and electrical systems. Individuals working on this project would have experience required to safely operate various systems. If required, licensed professionals would be hired to perform specific services outside of standard operating scope of those on staff. Systems installed would meet the necessary code requirements applicable for that region.

Solid wastes generated by this project would be limited to packaging materials for software and equipment utilized in software development and testing. All materials will be handled on-site and disposed of in accordance with local laws and available waste management systems. Recyclable materials shall be recycled whenever possible.

DOE has determined the development and demonstration of the SSOC would not have a significant individual or cumulative impact to human health and/or environment. DOE has determined the proposed project is consistent with actions contained in DOE categorical exclusions A9 "information gathering, analysis and dissemination" and B5.15 "Small-scale renewable energy research and development and pilot projects" and is categorically excluded from further NEPA review.
