Description:

A9 Information and dissemination

Information gathering (including, but not limited to, literature surveys, inventories, site visits, and gathering, analysis, audits), data analysis (including, but not limited to, computer modeling), document preparation (including, but not limited to, conceptual design, feasibility studies, and analytical energy supply and demand studies), and information dissemination (including, but not limited to, document publication and distribution, and classroom training and informational programs), but not including site characterization or environmental monitoring. A11 Technical advice and assistance to organizations

Rationale for determination:

DOE is proposing to provide federal funding to the Salt Lake Community College to continue advancing the Solar Instructor Training Network (SITN). DOE funding would be used to implement internet-based "train the trainer" courses for photovoltaics (PV) and ongoing professional development and networking opportunities for trainees and other key partners.

DOE made two previous NEPA determinations for Phase 1 (GF0-10-165; CX A9, A11 and B5.1; signed 2/1/10) and Phase 2-4 (GFO-0002090-003; CX A9, A11 and B5.16; signed 8/8/12), which involved curriculum development, the establishment of programs through instructor training, and selection of additional institutions to include in the SITN. The purpose of this NEPA determination is to review the funding of Phases 2-4 through a new award, DE-EE0005677.

Phases 2 - 4 would continue to facilitate the creation of a well-trained, solar energy workforce by selecting additional institutions to include in the SITN. The Rocky Mountain Solar Training Provider Network would be offering updated and advanced training and consultation to instructors at existing schools to maintain and increase their knowledge of current industry workings. Participating schools and associated instructors would then offer training to students by integrating learning objectives, instructional curriculum and training pertaining to installation and maintenance of solar arrays into new and/or existing courses and programs.

Based on a review of the project information and the above analysis, DOE has determined that the proposed project would not have a significant individual or cumulative impact to human health and/or environment. DOE has determined that this project is consistent with actions outlined in DOE categorical exclusions A9 "information gathering" and A11 "technical advice and assistance" and is therefore categorically excluded from further NEPA review.
