Rationale for determination:

The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) is proposing to provide federal funding to the Association of Village Council Presidents (AVCP), located in Bethel, Alaska, to support Alaska Native villages and corporations through information sharing, education, capacity building, and technical assistance.

AVCP will provide information to 56 Alaskan Native tribal governments in remote western Alaska along the Yukon River, Kuskokwin River and Bering Sea, to help promote clean energy and energy efficiency projects that reduce the cost of energy for rural, remote Alaskan Native villages.

Tasks include:

- · Sharing information through regional meetings or workshops;
- Providing education and outreach materials through web announcements and webinars;
- · Providing technical assistance for community based energy planning, project evaluation, and prioritization;
- Increasing the capacity of the AVCP staff to support clean energy and energy efficiency training.

For all tasks identified no new construction, permits, licenses, authorizations, or modifications to existing facilities will be required to conduct the work in these tasks.

No additional affects to resources or additional concerns were found to exist during this review.

Based on review of the project information and the above analysis, DOE has determined the project would not have a significant individual or cumulative impact to human health and/or environment. DOE has determined the proposed project is consistent with actions contained in DOE categorical exclusion A9 "information gathering, data analysis and computer modeling," A11 "technical advice and assistance to organizations," and therefore is categorically excluded from further NEPA review.
