Covered actions would be in accordance with applicable requirements (such as local land use and zoning requirements) in the proposed project area and would incorporate appropriate control technologies and best management practices.

Rationale for determination:

The Santo Domingo Tribe (Tribe) would utilize DOE and cost share funds for the planning, installation, and system performance evaluation of an approximate 115 kW DC ground mounted solar photovoltaic (PV) system that would power the Tribe's community water pump and treatment (WPT) facility located at the Santo Domingo Pueblo in New Mexico approximately 23 miles south of Santa Fe, New Mexico. The project and project location have been approved by the Tribal Council.

The WPT facility consists of a small cinderblock building enclosed by a fenced area of approximately 55 feet by 80 feet. The cinderblock building referred to as the pump house, encloses the water pumps and operating controls that pump, treat, and distribute potable water from two separate water wells. The proposed ground mount PV system installation would have a footprint of approximately 0.5 acres or less. All activities would be located within previously disturbed and developed areas. Ground disturbing activities would include concrete foundation anchors for the PV panels and excavation for routing of the electrical conduit. Prior to installing the existing WPT facility, the Indian Health Service conducted a cultural survey that confirmed the area was not located on or near any cultural, historic, or archaeological resources. Proposed work would occur on Tribal Trust land and no Bureau of Indian Affairs involvement is necessary because the Tribe is not requesting a surface lease, access road right of way or power line right of way. Due to the project area's location, previous disturbance, and the previous cultural survey for the area, DOE has determined that neither protected biological nor cultural/historic resources would be affected by project activities.

Based on review of the project information, DOE has determined that the project activities would not have a significant individual or cumulative impact to human health and/or environment. DOE has determined that these activities are consistent with actions contained in DOE categorical exclusions A9 "Information gathering, analysis, and dissemination," and B5.16 "Solar photovoltaic systems," and are categorically excluded from further NEPA review.
