Description:

Rationale for determination:

The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) is proposing to create demand for verified energy performance of new buildings and integrate tools that change owner's standard procurement processes by deploying three DOE developed software tools to a variety of stakeholders, and using existing utility programs to influence the market place via, one-on-one and group meetings and other communication means.

The proposed activities would include computer modeling, analytical reviews, conceptual designs, paper studies, personnel communications and education and outreach all to be completed by Seventhwave from their office in Madison, WI. Project activities would be limited exclusively to intellectual, academic, or analytical activities and would use no physical materials beyond basic office supplies and software.

Based on review of the project information and the above analysis, DOE has determined the proposed project would not have a significant individual or cumulative impact to human health and/or environment. DOE has determined that this project is consistent with actions outlined in DOE categorical exclusion A9 "Information gathering, analysis, and dissemination" and is therefore categorically excluded from further NEPA review.
