Rationale for determination:

The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) is proposing to provide federal funding to the Hydro Research Foundation (HRF) to award grants to individual research projects through its University Research Awards Program to support innovative research related to conventional or pumped-storage hydropower, stimulate interest among students and universities in this research arena, and provide students with a foundation for productive careers related to the hydropower industry.

DOE completed a previous NEPA review (GFO-0002668-002 CX A9, A11 3/23/2015) that included development of a Hydro Fellowship Program that would competitively award grants for hydropower-related, graduate-level research projects for one- to two-year periods of study. This NEPA determination applies to activities associated with one of the projects which has been selected to receive a grant award from the HRF.

The awardee at the University of California Berkeley would use HRF grant funding provided by DOE to determine whether the operating policies of dam and hydropower facilities can be associated with identifiable footprints recovered using the dynamic system theory. Proposed activities undertaken towards this goal would include analysis of high-quality, hydrologic, time series data from select dam sites across the United States with distinct operational policies; validation of site selection through policy and operational document analysis and expert interviews; and estimation of fractal dimensions from noisy time series to analyze the data sets and characterize the dimensionality of operations at each dam site. The proposed project would be limited exclusively to intellectual, academic, or analytical activities and would use no physical materials beyond basic office supplies and software.

Based on review of the project information and the above analysis, DOE has determined the activities associated with the proposed project would not have a significant individual or cumulative impact to human health and/or environment. DOE has determined the proposed project is consistent with actions contained in DOE categorical exclusions A9 "Information gathering, analysis, and dissemination" and A11 "Technical advice and assistance to organizations" is categorically excluded from further NEPA review.
