Rationale for determination:

The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) is proposing to provide federal funding to the City of Milwaukee to offer a variety of technical services to existing building owners, such as energy assessments, benchmarking, data analysis, and retrocommissioning.

The proposed activities would include deployment of Department of Energy tools and practices in Class B&C offices, schools and small commercial properties; expanding programmatic activities throughout the state; recruiting participants for the Better Buildings Challenge; and bundling energy efficiency services for participants such as project development, financing, and operations and maintenance support. The proposed project would use no physical materials beyond basic office supplies and software.

Based on review of the project information and the above analysis, DOE has determined the proposed project would not have a significant individual or cumulative impact to human health and/or environment. DOE has determined that this project is consistent with actions outlined in DOE categorical exclusions A9 "Information gathering, analysis, and dissemination" and A11 "Technical advice and assistance to organizations" and is therefore categorically excluded from further NEPA review.
