Rationale for determination:

The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) is proposing to provide federal funding to UtilityAPI to expand UtilityAPI's geographic coverage from three utilities to 15 utilities across the US.

Proposed project activities would include software and business development. Activities would consist solely of desktop research and computer analysis, and business development activities such as meetings, phone calls, and hiring staff. The proposed project would be limited exclusively to intellectual, academic, or analytical activities and would use no physical materials beyond basic office supplies and software.

Based on review of the project information and the above analysis, DOE has determined that the proposed project would not have a significant individual or cumulative impact to human health and/or environment. DOE has determined the proposed project is consistent with actions contained in DOE categorical exclusion A9 "information gathering, analysis and dissemination," and A11 "Technical advice" and is categorically excluded from further NEPA review.
