Rationale for determination:

The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) is proposing to provide federal funding to Aurora Solar, Inc. to develop a webbased application that uses sophisticated image recognition and computer vision techniques to construct three dimensional roof models with as little human intervention as possible.

Proposed activities would be limited exclusively to intellectual, academic, or analytical activities and would include data collection and performance benchmarking, development of algorithms, software development, customer engagement and training. Project participants would use no physical materials beyond basic office supplies and software.

Based on review of the project information and the above analysis, DOE has determined the proposed project would not have a significant individual or cumulative impact to human health and/or environment. DOE has determined that this project is consistent with actions outlined in DOE categorical exclusions A9 "Information gathering, analysis, and dissemination" and A11 "Technical advice and assistance to organizations" and is therefore categorically excluded from further NEPA review.
